1. Read a book
2. Choose a character from the book
3. Write or type an original speech, script or monologue as if you are that character. Mention details from the book. 150 words MAXIMUM.
4. Use one real quote from the book (the rest should be original)
5. Dress up as that character. Try to make as much of the costume by hand as you can. You can alter costume items that are purchased at a store. You must design the costume by yourself, but you can get help from others. (If you can't send us a picture of yourself, send us a drawing of the costume you are planning on making.)
6. Remember to include your name, grade, teacher, school and PHONE NUMBER and email (if you have one.)
